A motivation of no less than 150 words needs to accompany their application to be considered for a bursary.

A motivation of no less than 150 words needs to accompany their application to be considered for a bursary.

All applicants must have completed and passed 3 first academic year subjects before their applications will be considered. All applicants may be contacted for an interview with a SANA representative in their region.

A copy of your ID must be submitted along with your application. If additional supporting documents and ID are not attached, or the application form is not completed correctly, the application will be rejected.

Closing date for consideration will be 20 January 2019 for interviews the following March 2019. **NB:** Incomplete applications will not be considered.
